The Northeast Regional Node of the NOAA CoastWatch program, located at the National Marine Fisheries Laboratory (NMFS) Narragansett, Rhode Island, provides operational distribution of satellite products to researchers throughout the northeastern U.S. Principal among these products is our near-real-time imagery of derived sea-surface temperature fields (SST) and ocean reflectance data, from NOAA polar-orbiting AVHRR instruments.

CoastWatch regards the model products you have described as an important resource that will be used widely within the community of ocean scientists, fishery biologists and coastal ecosystem managers. As you may know, the CoastWatch Northeast Regional Node has a long-standing commitment to near-real-time distribution of its satellite and data products.
